### EMERGENCY RELIEF APPLICATION

Episcopal Charities of Southeast Florida has set aside funds from its *Blair and Agnes Smith Charity Fund* for parishioners of the Diocese of Southeast Florida who have emergency needs that fall within the focus areas of the Smith Charity Fund guidelines — feeding, clothing, shelter and healthcare needs for the needy youth and elderly.

Checks will be written to the parish, with the rector or senior warden as administrator of the funds. The maximum allowable amount to be distributed to a parish from this Emergency Fund is \$1,000 within a two-year period. The Grants Committee of Episcopal Charities of Southeast Florida shall make the distribution determinations.
